Deadline to apply is APRIL 1st, 2025

The Knights of Columbus Council #50 is proud to offer scholarships for educational purposes. The Council expects to award (2) scholarships with a minimum \$750 each. Depending on the number of applicants and the monies available to be awarded, the committee may elect to award additional scholarships or increase the amount of the award.

General Program Requirements:

the applicant must be

- an active and practicing Catholic, and
- a communicant of a Parish in Enfield or a parish in the community they reside in, and
- related to a current or deceased Council 50 member in good standing, and
- a graduating high school senior or currently attending a 2 or 4 year college as a full-time student, and
- in good academic standing with a minimum 3.0 GPA.

Terms and Conditions

- This Scholarship will be offered on an ongoing basis until the Knights of Columbus Council 50, at their sole discretion, terminates the Scholarship program.
- The Educational Scholarship Awards will be granted based on the following factors:
 - The funds and resources available for the Scholarship Program.
 - The relative merit of applicant, as determined by Council 50's scholarship committee's sole discretion.
- Applications must be received by the application deadline. Late submissions will not be considered.
- There will be (2) scholarships awarded. One for a young man and one for a young woman.

Scholarship Program Rules

- Applicant fully authorizes Council 50 to validate information provided on the scholarship application, including but not limited to, parish membership status, G.P.A., extracurricular activities and community service.
- Scholarships will be awarded annually.
- Applicants may reapply for consideration each year.
- Scholarship winners cannot reapply.

Recipient Rights and Obligations

- Recipient has (1) year from the date of the award to use the scholarship award toward post-secondary education.
- Scholarship awards that are claimed but not collected within (90) days will be forfeited.
- Scholarship recipients authorize Council 50 to post their name, picture, and brief description of award recipient. Council 50 will seek recipient's permission if any additional application information is requested for publishing.
